On behalf of the board of directors of Ephrata Area Social Services, the staff and those we serve, I want to thank you for your generous donation of FOOD to the EASS, for the FOOD BANK.

*We are grateful for the continued support shown for EASS and its mission. We are able to do what we do because of your faith, and trust, in us...*

During **April, 2013**, EASS distributed food to **216** families, helping **688** people. **280** people benefited from the Clothing Bank. We provided **153** rides through the Transportation Service. We also helped **18** New Families, having **37** members. **41** families (**126** family members) benefited from our *Emergency Financial Assistance Program (Discretionary Funds)* expending **\$6,242.20** in financial assistance to help with prescriptions, home heating fuel, **electric payments to prevent disconnections** and with emergency overnight lodging.

Greetings!

I have exciting news to share with all of you. Lutheran Social Ministry of New Jersey has just opened housing for disaster response volunteers in New Jersey - on the beach, in Long Branch, NJ! LSMNJ is working with two churches who can house up to 35 people collectively. I spoke with Amy Pennenga, the Disaster Response Coordinator for LSMNJ, yesterday and she explained that they are very much in the infancy stages of this response but would love to have an experienced group like ours.

We discussed possible weeks when we could come down in late summer/early fall. I have asked her to tentatively reserve the week of September 8-14 for our group. The week before is Labor Day week and the week after is already booked. Too much later in the year would become very difficult. This is the week of the Denver Fair and I realize that might eliminate some of you from consideration. The cost would likely not exceed \$200 per person and Amy does not expect it to be that high.

I would like to have a meeting to discuss this possibility with anyone who may have an interest in helping our brothers and sister in New Jersey. If you have an interest in learning more about this opportunity to serve, please plan to attend an informational meeting at Trinity, New Holland, Sunday, June 30<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 p.m. Tell anyone, especially those with construction skills, to come out for the meeting and learn more. If you are unable to make the meeting but are interested in going along, please email or call me. **The first 35 people who express definite interest in this trip will secure a spot.** Space is limited.

Hope to see you on June 30<sup>th</sup>!

## COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

May 2013

Your Council met Wednesday, May 15, 2013. Highlights include:

**Pastor Trout** reported that the Annual Synod Conference will be held June 6-8. Guy Templin, Connie Taylor, Bonnie Oplinger and Pastor Trout and Bonnie will be attending. This is an important meeting as they will be casting their vote for the new Bishop.

**Scouts** reported that the boys are working on their pre-requisites for Eagle Camp. They will be having a camping weekend to do some wood splitting and cleanup/painting of the cabin.

**Service committee** reported that the pig stomach dinner netted about \$1800 and that they are seeking matching funds from Thrivent, so that total amount they are giving to the Disaster Response team should be over \$2000. Again they want to thank everyone that helped.

**Love, Inc. committee** reported that the family currently living in the house has double good news in April. They had a new baby daughter born and the husband landed a full time job. Homes of Hope committee will be having a food wagon at Adamstown Community days and is looking for volunteers to work the 2 hour shifts. See Bob Christy or Cindy Golden if interested.

**Welcome committee** reported that they mailed out 81 cards this month and are setting up visits with current sick and shut-ins to delivery prayer shawls. They are also in the preliminary stages of investigating a support group for caregiving spouses.

**Helping Hands committee** presented the Use of Facilities Guidelines, which was approved by Council. The Guidelines are posted on the bulletins boards throughout church and in the kitchen.

**Disaster Response committee** wanted to thank everyone for their support of their trip to Minot. The Minot project will be completed by this time next year. There will be a Minot Reunion celebration on Sunday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Ephrata at 7:00pm. There will be a presentation on the trip. Please park in the rear of the church and enter through the new building doors.

**Property committee** reported that they will be continuing with the replacement of mulch with stone in the flowerbeds and this year will be doing the area on the side of the church, from the front steps to the library. The annual work day is scheduled for Monday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:00pm. Everyone is welcome to come and help. We have weeding, edging, mulching and lots of stone to place. A landscaping plan has been developed for the oval flower bed at the back entrance and memorial money will be used to purchase the shrubbery, etc. The capping of the beams in the front of the church has been completed.

**Learning** reported that Confirmation was held on Sunday, May 19. May 19<sup>th</sup> was also the last day for Sunday School and it will resume the Sunday after Labor day.

**Youth Group** reported that they will be going to The Works on June 2<sup>nd</sup> at 10:30am.

**Public Relations committee** is in the process of being formed. Randy Gockley will be chairing the committee. Anyone interested in serving on this committee should see Sue Knauer or Randy Gockley.

June 2013

Your Council met Wednesday, June 19, 2013. Highlights include:

Pastor Trout reported that confirmation camp went well and that 22 students attended.

**Scouts** reported that the boys helped with the mulching and stoning of the flowerbeds and several will be attending the Eagle Camp in July.

**Service committee** reported that we are again participating with the Summer Meal Program. We will have a week in August again and will need 9 volunteers. Please see Dave Kupp if you interested in helping. We will also be participating in the community meal that is served at the Methodist church on Main Street in Denver. We will be taking a turn and making the meal here at Swamp and then delivering it to them to be served. They reminded us about the CALM 5 ice cream social the will be held on July 28th. It is a fund raiser for the Habitat for Humanity house and advanced tickets are on sale for \$5.00 per person, see Dave Kupp.

**Finance Committee** presented an Investment Policy Statement and Council approved it. Council authorized the Finance Committee to invest \$190,000 based on this policy.

**Disaster Response committee** reported that there will be a local trip this September (8-14). Glenn Beard Jr. has been in contact with the Lutheran Social Ministries of NJ Longbranch and the team is heading to NJ. The cost will not exceed \$200 per person and there are only 35 spaces available that will be filled on a first come basis. There will be an informational meeting on Sunday, June 30 at 2:00pm at New Holland Trinity.

**Property committee** reported that the mulching and stoning of the flowerbeds has been completed and thanks everyone for that helped. The landscaping and planting of the oval flowerbed in the back of the church is complete and the sign installation is in progress.

**Worship committee** reported the Synod is focusing on Stewardship this year and has adopted the ELCA Malaria Campaign as its mission project. We will be focusing on these two items as well.

**Learning committee** reported that VBS will be held July 7-11 and registration forms are available on the website and in the church office.

**Youth Group** reported that CALM 5 is holding a Family Pool Party on Friday, July 12 from 6-8pm at the Adamstown pool. Cost is \$2.00 person for non-members of the pool. Sign up sheets are posted at both ends of the church.

**New Business** included us winning the bid to purchase the triangular property that borders our property and several other properties in the Sunrise Garden Development. The church bid \$1 and the Township accepted our bid. Settlement on the property will be in the next 30 days.

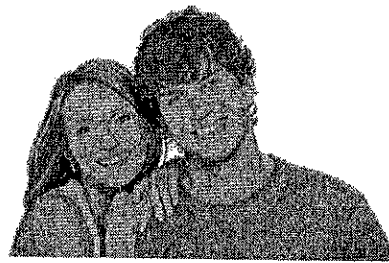
## What you need:

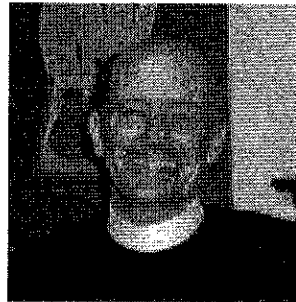

## James S. Dunlop Elected Bishop of Our Synod

The Rev. James S. Dunlop was elected bishop of the Lower Susquehanna Synod on the fifth ballot by the voting members of the 2013 annual Synod Assembly held June 6-8 at Messiah College in Grantham, PA.



**Bishop-elect Dunlop**

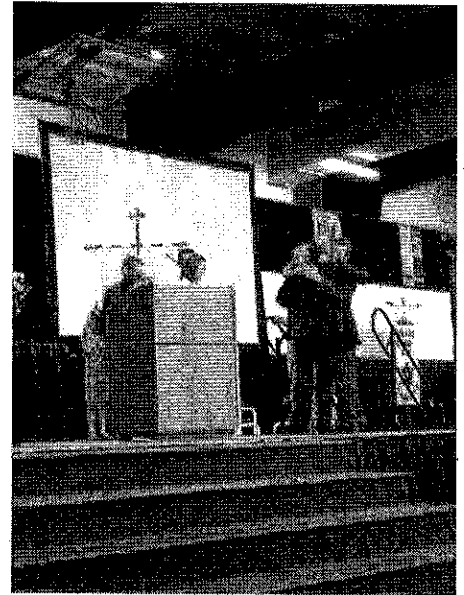
Bishop-elect Dunlop will succeed Bishop B. Penrose Hoover effective September 1, 2013, to lead the synod's 239 worshipping communities. Bishop-elect Dunlop is the fourth bishop elected since the ELCA was formed in 1988 from three predecessor Lutheran bodies.

The Rev. James S. Dunlop currently serves as pastor of St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church in Littlestown, PA. Ordained in 2005, Dunlop received the Master's of Divinity from the Lutheran Theological Seminary Gettysburg in 2005, and the Bachelor of Arts, Magna Cum Laude, from Gettysburg College in 1978. He has served as chairperson of the Compensation and Benefits Committee and as a member of the Budget and Finance Committee of the Lower Susquehanna Synod. He is Dean of the Hanover Conference and is a voting member to the ELCA Churchwide Assembly in 2013. Dunlop has served as both president and secretary of the Littlestown Ministerium.

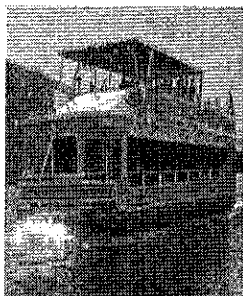
When asked about the principal priority for the Lower Susquehanna Synod, Rev. Dunlop said "The principal priority for the Church in changing times must be to identify, strengthen and support the

leaders in the Church so that they may serve the mission of the Church and the word of God may continue to spread.

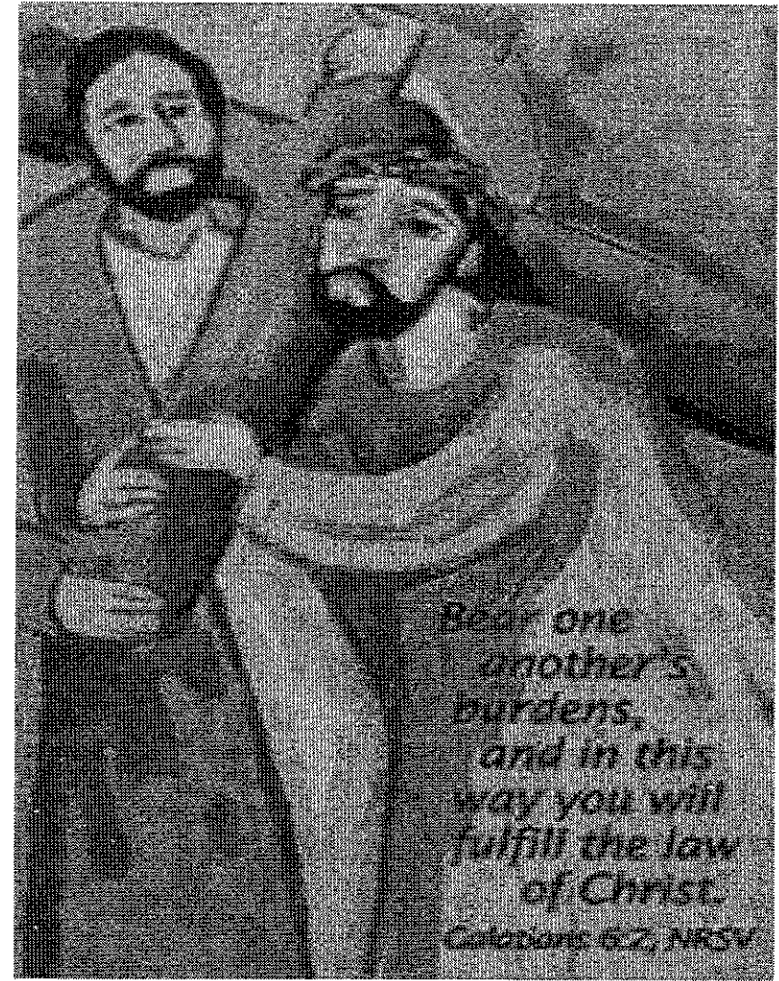
